Creating an IRCC secure online account

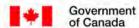
Creating a secure online account with Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) allows you to apply online for documents like study permits, work permits, and visitor visas.

This guide walks you through how to create an IRCC secure online account.


We recommend the GCKey option. Click "Sign in with GCKey".

You will be directed to the "Welcome to GCKey" page. Click "Sign Up" on the right.




Review the "Terms and Conditions of Use" and click "I accept" if you agree.



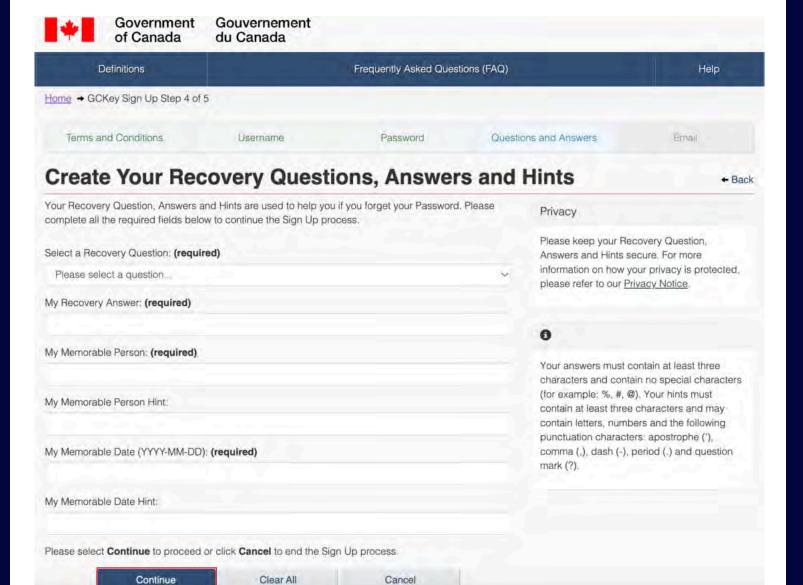
Create your username following the requirements on the right side of the page.

Tip: save your username in a safe place, in case you forget it.



Create and confirm your password following the requirements on the right side of the page.

Tip: save your password in a safe place, in case you forget it.



Select and answer your recovery questions.

Create a hint and provide a memorable person and a memorable date.

Tip: be specific when creating a hint (for example: my first name, my birthday) so that you know exactly what the answers should be.



You have the option to provide your email address to recover your username or password (recommended).



When you have successfully created your GCKey, you will see a page that says "GCKey Sign Up Complete".
Click "Continue".



If you provided your email address, you will be sent a confirmation code by email.



By accessing your account, you are agreeing to abide by the following Terms and Conditions of Use:



On the "Create an account" page, enter your name, email address, and preferred language of notification.

Tip: Provide your name exactly as it appears on your passport or identity document.



Create your security questions

You will need to answer one of your security questions each time you access your account. You will have two tries to answer the question.

If you can't answer the first security question, we will ask you another one of your four questions. If you can't answer any of your security questions, we will lock your account. You will not be able to recover your account online.

Create new security questions that are difficult to guess but are easy for you to remember.

Create your security questions and answers. You will need to answer one of your security questions every time you sign in to your IRCC secure online account.

Tip: be specific when creating your security questions (for example: my first name, country where I was born, city where I was born, my nationality) so that you know exactly what the answers should be.
