Provincial Attestation Letter Exemption Explanation

Dear Officer,

I am applying for a Temporary Resident Visa (TRV) and would like to provide additional information to support my **exemption from a Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL)** in my application.

I am a current student at the University of British Columbia (UBC) with a valid study permit and I am exempt from a PAL for my TRV application since according to IRCC's Provincial attestation letter or territorial attestation letter website <https://www.canada.ca/en/immigration-refugees-citizenship/services/study-canada/study-permit/get-documents/provincial-attestation-letter.html>, PALs are only required for study permit applications, not Temporary Resident Visa applications.
